The etiology of developmental language disorders is not yet completely understood. However, in the past two decades much work has been done towards unraveling the molecular underpinnings of such disorders, with particular progress made in understanding their genetic basis. In the first part of my talk I will introduce concepts and methods in genetics and disease-gene mapping in human genetics in particular (no prior knowledge is assumed). I will then survey the field of language impairment genetics from the discovery of the first gene implicated in a speech and language disorder to recent genome-wide studies of language impairment and language-related traits and functional studies. I will also present my own work on the genetics of specific language impairment. I will conclude my talk by outlining the ways in which new and emerging technologies could further our understanding of language impairment, discussing both the clinical and the molecular aspects of these efforts.
